

Resolution No. 2025-09

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered under authority of Section 321 of the Code of Iowa with a duty to place within the City limits suitable standard signs showing the points at which the rate of speed changes and the maximum rate of speed in the district which the vehicle is entering; and,

WHEREAS, the Cerro Gordo County Engineer and the Franklin County Engineer shares jurisdiction of the road in question and approves of the erection of speed limit signs on Maryland Street aka Cerro Gordo Street aka 100th Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council believes there is a need to slow traffic in this area of Meservey for the safety and protection of residents and visitors alike.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Meservey that they do hereby authorize the Franklin County Engineer to have erected speed limit signs on Maryland Street to the East and West of 1st Street aka Balsam Avenue in Meservey, Iowa.
